Sealed bids are requested for labor and materials to renovate rental units for the Housing Authority of Washington County (HAWC). Bids will be received at the Department of Housing Services (Housing Authority of Washington County) offices, 111 NE Lincoln St. #200-L, Hillsboro, Oregon 97124, until 2:00 p.m. on the 11th day of September 1996, shortly thereafter, bids will be opened and publicly read. The locations in Washington County where the work is to be performed will be identified later. Contractors may bid on all, or any subcontract portion, of the specified work.
