Sealed bids will be received by the Purchasing Agent of the City of Vancouver, Washington, up to the hour of 11:00 a.m., Pacific Time, Monday, October 14, 1996, and publicly opened and read aloud at 11:00 a.m. on the same day in the Council Chambers on the First Floor of City Hall, 210 East 13th Street, Vancouver, Washington, for the following:

The construction of pedestrian ramps, sidewalks, curbs, and associated work as shown on the plans for Project No. Z9558, **Sidewalk Improvements for the Hough Neighborhood:**

Approximate Quantities: 330 S.Y. Remove Cement Concrete Sidewalk, 130 S. Y. Cement Concrete Sidewalk, 345 L.F. Sawcutting, 170 S.Y. Interlocking Concrete Pavers, Crown and Root Pruning for 19 trees, 50 S.Y. Cement Concrete driveway, 55 L.F. Cement Concrete Curb, among other items required.

Please note that in order to minimize disruption to the neighborhoods involved, no more than one block (between cross streets) at a time may be constructed.

This project is financed through the Community Development Block Grant program with funds obtained from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. The Contract will be subject to regulations of the Department of Labor and Housing and Urban Development.

Attention is called to Federal Provisions for Equal Employment Opportunity, HUD Section 3 requirements, and the minimum wages as set forth in the Contract Documents.

All bids shall be addressed to the attention of the Purchasing Agent, Vancouver City Hall, 210 East 13th Street, P. O. Box 1995, Vancouver, Washington 98668. All bids delivered shall be delivered to the Purchasing Agent, Lower Level, City Hall, 210 East 13th Street. Bids shall be placed in an envelope which is sealed and which clearly states the name of the bidder, the date of the bid opening, and appropriate wording to indicate definitely the nature of the contents. **Do not send bids by Fax.** Bids submitted via Fax will not be accepted.

The Contract is for public work subject to ORS 279.348 to 279.363. No bid will be received or considered by Depoe Bay or any officer thereof unless the bid contains a statement by the Bidder as a part of their bid that the provisions required by

ORS 279.350 (relating to prevailing wages) shall be included in the Contract.

Bidders on this work will be required to comply with the provisions of the President's Executive Order No. 11246 concerning equal employment opportunity, including all amendments and requirements issued thereunder. The requirements for Bidders and Contractors under this Order are explained in the Contract Documents.

Any Contract award under this Notice to Contractors is expected to be funded by a grant from the United States Department of Agriculture through the Rural Development, Neither the United States nor any of its departments, agencies, or employees is or will be a party to this Notice to Contractors of any resulting contract. Woolsey Avenue, Portland, Oregon 97203, until 2:00 p.m., Thursday, October 24, 1996, for labor and materials for renovations at an existing nine story high-rise building.
