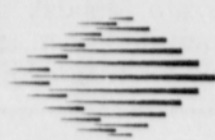

Development Of Mixed Income Housing On The N.E. 60th And Glisan Site

The Portland Development Commission (PDC) is soliciting proposals for the development of a medium density, transit supportive, mixed income housing project on a 4.88 acre site at N.E. 60th and Glisan. The site is bordered by Interstate 84 (I-84) to the north, Glisan street to the south, 60th Street to the east and an I-84 westbound on-ramp and eastbound off-ramp to the west. North of the site across I-84 is the 60th Avenue MAX light rail station.

PDC invites proposals from development teams, setting forth their experience and qualifications, financial capabilities and a preliminary business plan addressing the development program and other issues identified in the Request for Proposal (RFP) package.
