Touring nationally since 1987, Jamie is making her fourth appearance in Portland. She's known for her solid songwriting and engaging stage presence. With a voice as smooth as Mary Chapin Carpenter and a sense of humor as wacky as Randy Newman, she has entertained in hundreds of coffeehouses, concert halls and festivals. Her five recordings include the newest one, "Never Assume," produced by Lisa Koch (Dos Fallopias) and recorded in Washington state.

Her songs range from the poignant ballad "One Out of Three" (about breast cancer) to the hilarious "When Cats Take Over the World." "Midnight Alice," a love song to her first car, received airplay nationally

on NPR's "Car Talk."

Jamie is a two-time winner of the Tucson Area Music Award for Best Acoustic/Folk Performer.

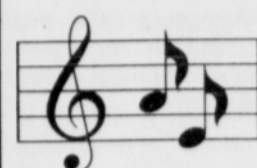
