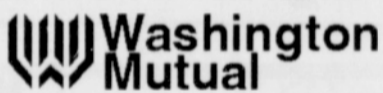

Sealed bids for the Portland International Airport Wildlife Deterrent Fence project will be received at the office of the Manager, Contracts and Procurement, of The Port of Portland, 700 N.E. Bidders are required to show that small subcontractors, suppliers, or manufacturers which have been certified by the Oregon State Office of Minority, Women, and Emerging Small Business as disadvantaged, minority, or women business enterprises (collectively "Disadvantaged Business Enterprises" or "DBEs") will participate in not less than 20 percent of the total dollar amount bid.

Description of Work:

Furnish and install approximately 36,500 linear feet of chain link fabric buried in the ground and fastened to an existing chain link fence so as to form a continuous barrier; construct reinforced concrete pads at existing gates and apply weed control material on areas disturbed by the installation of the underground fabric. Necessary utility locates form part of the scope of this project.
