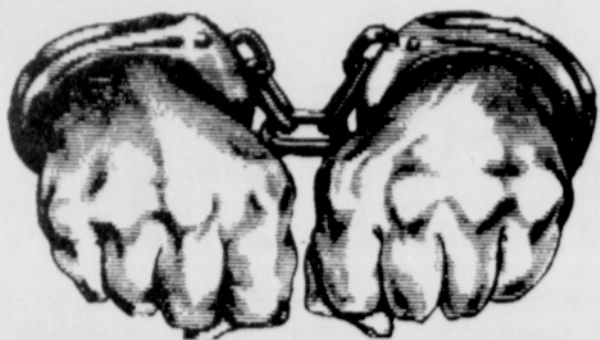

Crime Stoppers

Armed Robbery

Portland Police Bureau Detectives, in cooperation with Crime Stoppers, are asking for your help in identifying and apprehending the person responsible for a series of armed robberies at Portland area taverns.

Investigators believe the same individual is responsible for at least five robberies in the last month. Taverns struck by the gunman include:
August 17, 1997 Old Lompoc Tavern 1616 NW 23rd Avenue
August 18, 1997 Brooklyn Station 3400 SE Milwaukie Boulevard
August 18, 1997 Montana's Bar 11721 SE Stark Street

August 21, 1997 The Bullpen Tavern 1730 SW Taylor Street
August 25, 1997 The Ship Ahoy Tavern 2880 SE Gladstone Street

The robberies occurred between the hours of 9:30 in the evening and 12:30 in the morning.

The suspect will enter a tavern through the back door and confront the bartender. He carries a bag which the bartender is ordered to fill with money.

The suspect is described as a male of unknown race, 5'8" to 6'0" tall, with a medium build.

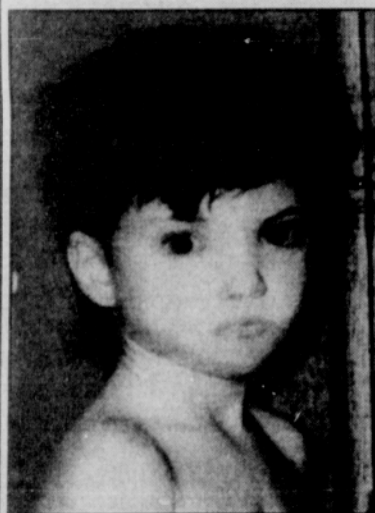
Witnesses say he speaks with a Hispanic, Russian, or Middle Eastern accent, and covers his face with a black ski mask with red stitching around the mouth.

He wears all black clothing including gloves, and is armed with a black handgun.

Children At Risk

The Multnomah County Child Abuse Team, in cooperation with Crime Stoppers, is asking for your help in identifying the names and current location of three children. Photographs obtained by in-



vestigators depict a white female child approximately 11 to 12 years of age with shoulder length dark colored hair and brown eyes, a white male child approximately 5 years of age with brown hair and blue eyes, and a baby approximately 1 years old.

There is concern for the children's welfare and they are considered to be at an immediate risk. Investigators are looking for any information that may assist in identifying the three children. It is believed that they are still in the Portland Metro Area.

Burglar Alarm Systems Need Permits

If your home or business has a burglar alarm system in Multnomah County you are required to obtain an alarm permit through the Sheriff's Office. While the majority of alarm users comply, some are unaware that permits are necessary.

The permit is easy to obtain and costs \$12 a year (permits are free to homeowners over 62 years of age). By registering an alarm system, alarm users get the following benefits:

* entry into the 911 data base to expedite police dispatches to an

alarm call

* a permit sticker to display on the home or business, alerting police that an alarm system is being used and warning would-be criminals of the same

* false alarm prevention information by phone and mail

Two permits are needed if your alarm system has both burglary and robbery alarm capabilities.

the expense of the care. "We provide the best eye care you could get anywhere," he says. "We don't r' mp on anything." Despite this, he says, the center gets only about 10 to 15 patients per day, well below its capacity. It receives relatively few referrals, Aldredge says.

He hopes to correct this by outreach to schools, churches and community groups.

A native of California, Aldredge moved to Portland from Oakland four years ago. He was drawn here, he says, by his "love of the outdoors. I've found Portland to have much of the atmosphere of the Bay area."

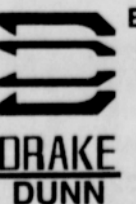
