Early Childhood Education Centers Still Have Openings for 4-Year-Olds

Parents of 4-year-olds who are looking for prekindergarten programs that can help youngsters learn school skills should check out Sabin, King and Humboldt early childhood education centers.

Those three schools still have openings in half-day programs that give children socialization skills as well as beginning literacy and math skills. Morning and afternoon classes help children prepare for all-day kindergarten programs offered at Portland's early childhood education centers, and for other kindergarten programs.

Enrollment in the schools is open to all children living within the Portland School District boundaries. Children must have been 4 years old by Sept. 1. Transportation is provided to students living within the feeder school area of each center; families must provide transportation for students living outside that area.

Families interested in enrolling their children should call the schools to arrange a visit or receive more information. Sabin School is located at 4013 NE 18th (916-6482); King School is at 4906 NE 6th (916-6456); Humboldt School is at 4915 N Gantenbein (916-5468).

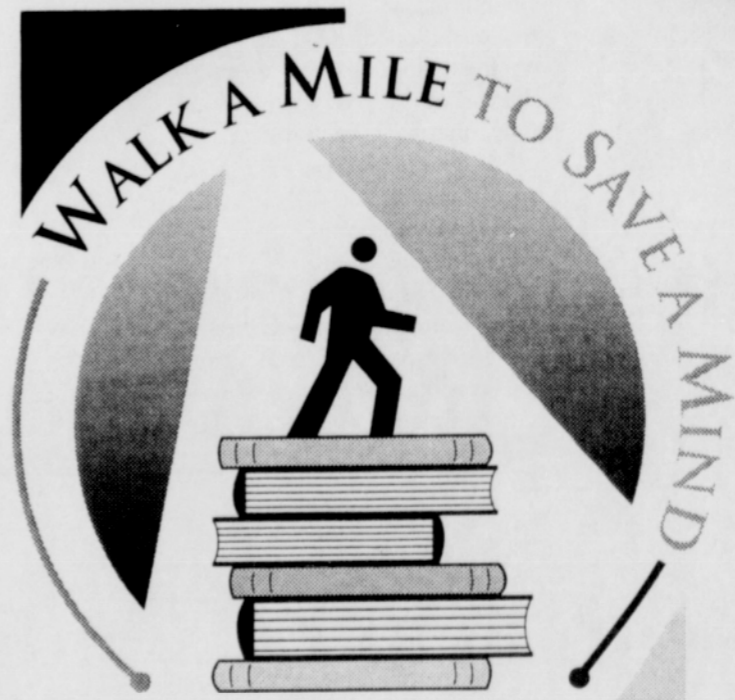
