The Metropolitan Wastewater Management Commission (MWMC) is soliciting proposals for consult services to develop a comprehensive Wet Weather Flow Management Plan (WWFMP) for the wastewater collection and treatment facilities in the Eugene/Springfield metropolitan area. The WWFMP will evaluate regional collection system characteristics in peak wet weather conditions, and develop cost-effective strategies to address extraneous Infiltration and Inflow (I/I) in the collection system, and its effects on the regional wastewater treatment facilities.

MWMC will evaluate proposals based on the following criteria:

- A. Understanding and responsiveness;
 - B. Experience with similar projects;
 - C. Timeliness of project schedule;
 - D. Overall experience and qualifications, demonstrated through written proposals, oral interviews, and reference inquiries;
 - E. Cost; and
 - F. Past dealings with Eugene, Springfield, and/or MWMC.
- An oral presentation and interview may be conducted with consultants who submit the top-rated proposals. The interviews will test the consultants on the evaluation criteria and will be performed by an evaluation committee.
