The Metropolitan Wastewater Management Commission (MWMC) is soliciting proposals for engineering services related to development of new biosolids management facilities, equipment and processes which includes design of a belt filter press dewatering facility and evaluation of opportunities available for expanded biosolids composting and for upgrading biosolids produced to a "Class A" Product.

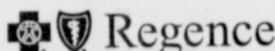
