

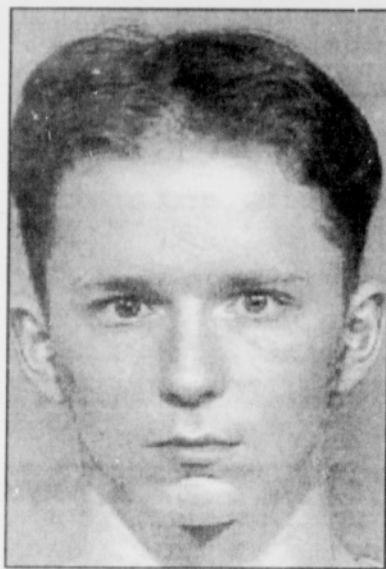

Wanted Subject

The Portland Police Bureau's Auto Theft Task Force, in cooperation with Crime Stoppers, is asking for your help in locating and apprehending Erick Anthony Eivers.

Arrest warrants are on file with the Cannon Beach Police, Washington County Sheriff's Office, Multnomah County Sheriff's Office and Clackamas County Sheriff's Office on charges ranging from D.U.I.I. to Contempt of Court and Failure to Appear on First Degree Forgery.

Erick Anthony Eivers is a 19-year-old white male (DOB 02-03-78). He is 5'9" and weighs approximately 135 pounds with



brown hair and green eyes. Recent aliases used include Martin D. Dowell, Dustin O. Duvall, Walt Richard Rogers, Brian Leroy Dirks, and Brian Allen Higgs.

SHOOTING/HOMICIDE 4048 NE Mallory Avenue

On Saturday, December 20, 1997, at 3:41 in the morning, Northeast Precinct Uniform Officers were dispatched to 4048 NE Mallory Avenue on a report of a disturbance with shots fired. Upon arrival, officers found a large number of people both inside and outside the house.

Inside, officers found a 28-year-old black male, later identified as Stacy Sabb, of northeast Portland, suffering from apparent gunshot wounds. Sabb was transported by ambulance to a local hospital where he later died.

Also, inside the house, officers found a group of people hold-

ing a young black male believed to be in his early 20's, who, according to the group, was the shooter.

Upon taking the subject from the group, officers discovered the subject was also suffering from an apparent gunshot wound.

The subject, who has not been positively identified, was transported by ambulance to a local hospital where he underwent surgery.

The circumstances surrounding the shooting and how both subjects were shot is still under investigation.

Update: Shooting/Homicide

The wounded subject, who was being held by a group of people when police arrived at 4048 NE Mallory, has been identified as 20-year-old Edwin LaShawn Williams of Northeast Portland.

Investigators charged Williams with Murder in connection with the shooting death of 28-year-old Stacy Sabb.

Williams, according to investigators, claims he was injured when he exchanged gunfire with Sabb during a confrontation over a gambling issue.

Edwin Williams is currently being held under guard at a local area hospital.

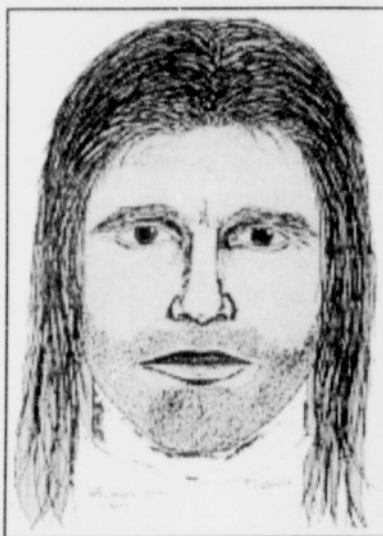
Crime Stoppers: Rape

Portland Police Bureau investigators, in cooperation with Crime Stoppers, are asking for your help identifying and apprehending the suspect in a rape.

On Sunday, December 7, 1997, at approximately 3 o'clock in the afternoon, the victim heard a knock at the door of her apartment, located near the MAX light rail line at SE 162nd Avenue and E Burnside Street. When she did not see anyone through the peephole, she opened the door to look. Once the door was open, the suspect forced his way in and sexually assaulted the victim.

The suspect is described as a white male, in his late 20's to early 30's, 6'0" tall, with a slender build, dark complexion, and scraggly-looking straight dark brown or black hair past his shoulders. The suspect appeared unshaven, and was wearing a black long-sleeve T-shirt, blue jeans, a brown leather belt with a square brass buckle, and dark-colored gloves.

Arrest in homicide Los Angeles, California

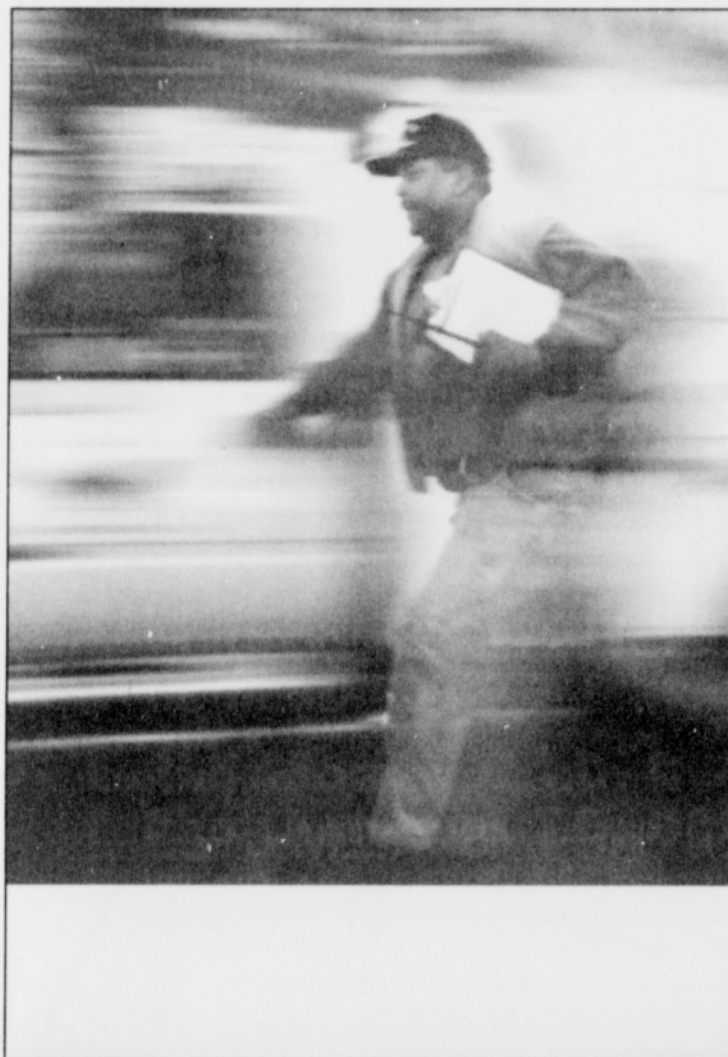
