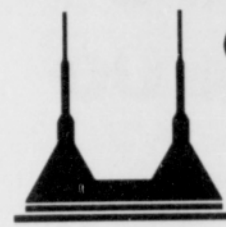

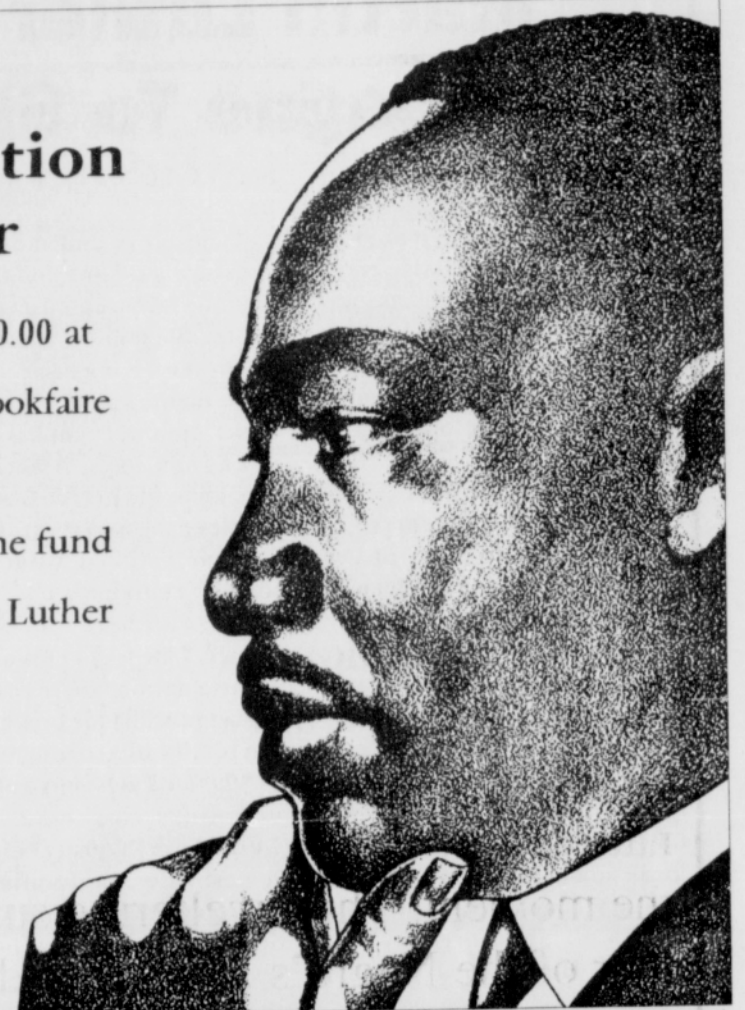
Martin Luther King, Jr., and the Reverend Glenn Smiley on the first integrated bus ride in Montgomery, Alabama.

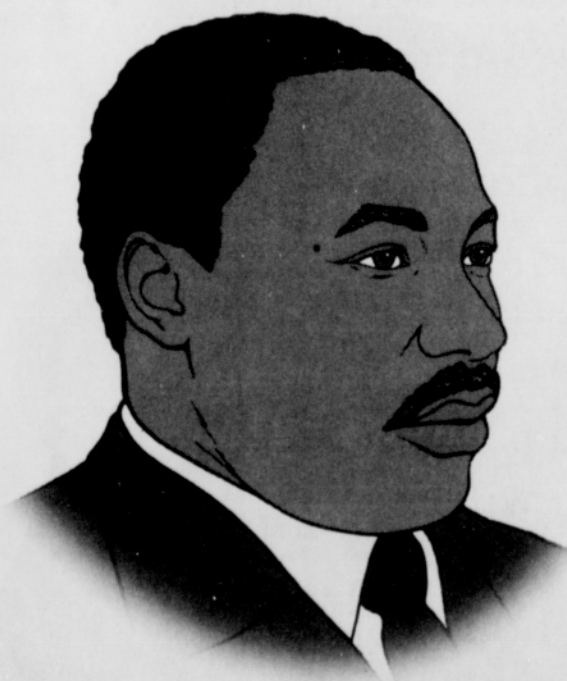

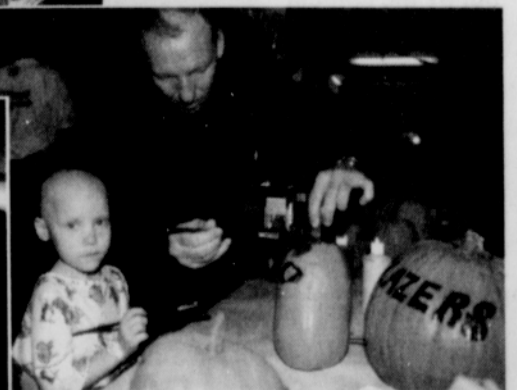
