At that time, the Bids will be opened and publicly read aloud at the MERC Conference Room.

The Work contemplated consists of the installation, plumbing of and access to a new cooling tower at the Civic Auditorium, located at 222 S.W. Clay, Portland, OR. The purpose of the project is to add a cooling tower to the HVAC system of the Civic Auditorium, which currently has no cooling tower capability.

Each Bid must be submitted on the prescribed form and accompanied by a certified check or cashier's check or Bid Bond executed on the prescribed form, payable to MERC in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the total bid amount. The Bid and bid security should be delivered in a sealed envelope marked "Portland Civic Auditorium, Cooling Tower Project, Attention: Mark Hunter."

The successful Bidder will be required to furnish the necessary additional bonds for the faithful performance of the Contract and for the payment of all persons supplying labor and materials as prescribed in the Contract Documents.

Bidders must comply with ORS 279.350 requiring payment of prevailing wage rates, ORS 279.029 requiring a statement as to whether the Bidder is a resident bidder, and ORS 701.035-90 requiring Bidders and subcontractors to be registered with the Oregon Construction Contractor's Board. Bidder shall use recyclable products to the maximum extent economically feasible in the performance of the Contract Work and must also comply with Metro-MERC Minority Business Enterprise, Women-Owned Business Enterprise, and Emerging Small Business Program.
