## Director Jordan re-opens discussions on the Holocaust Memorial

Parks Director Charles Jordan has re-opened discussions of the siting of the proposed Holocaust Memorial in an effort to allow the organizations involved to arrive at a decision that both viewpoints can support.

"This is far too important to be a subject of such division," stated Mr. Jordan.

"All parties involved have said that they want to have the holocaust Memorial.

I would like to provide an opportunity to build upon the shared desire for a Holocaust Memorial and see if a mutually agreeable site can be found, or if the current site can be made acceptable to the neighbors."

Director Jordan has accepted an offer by attorney and profes-

sional mediator Doug Capps to facilitate discussions between members of the Memorial Coalition and the Arlington heights Neighborhood Association over the course of the next 45 days.

Mr. Jordan has charged Mr. Capps to work with the parties involved to review the current site and other sites, as well as to review the memorial design to see if consensus can be reached.

If, during the course of 45 days, it seems that the parties are not able to render a mutual decision, then Mr. Jordan will make a decision on or before April 24, 1998.

"Until then, I have faith in the process of discussion and in Mr. Capp's ability to bring reasonable people together to find mutually acceptable solutions,"

stated Director Jordan.

In a letter issued today to over 200 interested individuals and organizations, Mr. Jordan indicated he will make his decision on or before April 24, 1998. At that time, he will issue a de-

cision on the proposed siting and design. That decision can be appealed in writing to Commissioner Jim Francesconi within 14 days of Mr. Jordan's official decision in writing.

If appeals are received, Parks Commissioner Francesconi will render his ruling by the close of business 14 days after that.

Commissioner Francesconi's decision may be appealed to the full Council within fourteen days.

All appeals must be requested in writing within the time frame stated above.

## Celebration Of Brotherhood

On February 27, George Fox held a Celebration of Brotherhood.

This is the first time the City of Newberg has celebrated Black History.

The celebration centered around the Mitchell-Phillips family.

Twenty two years ago, the first African American family moved into the City of Newberg. Their presence brought much suspicion and opposition.

The opinions began to change and more than two decades later the same family are now prominent and productive citizens of Newberg. The city that once opposed the arrival of the Mitchell-Phillips family now join hands with them to promote a week of peace and brotherhood.

There were many activities going on in that week including the Mayor of the City of Newberg presenting a proclamation to the Mitchell-Phillips family.
