Saxophonist, Angella Christie Records New Project - Live



Angella Christie, the first and reigning female Christian saxophonist in the nation recorded her first live session Friday, April 3, 1998 at her home church, new Birth Missionary Baptist Church Decatur Ga., where Bishop Eddie L. Long is Sr. Pastor.

The recording marks Christie's second national release entitled, "Hymn & i" on Atlanta International Record Co. (AIR-Gospel). Scheduled for a July street date, it is the first live instrumental gospel recording in more than two decades and Christie's first full concert in Atlanta.

The silent songstress' sophomore project is an 11-hymn compilation of songs all correlated with her life experiences. The Lord's prayer, Great Is Thy Faithfulness, Blessed Assurance and Oh Happy Day are but a few of the hymns and spiritual songs presented in this highly anticipated classic. "Hymn & i" displays her versatility from sacred sounds to urban grooves.

Recorded live and in-studio, "Hymn & i" features background vocals by Keith Brooks & New Creation with Maurice Culpepper.

Angella, along with producer Rick Carter of ODM Productions, assembled an all star band of some of gospel's leading musicians. Completing the set were Atlanta's own, Tres Gilbert ("Simply Redeemed"), Rick Carter (producer, "Eternity"), Derrick Cooper (co-producer, "Everlasting Love" - Keith Brooks & New Creation), Kevin Griffin, Sheryl Harper, and Brian Andrews and Derrick Jackson of Memphis and Sharrod Barnes of North Carolina.

The project is accompanied by a live concert video as well as a concept video based on a remix of Andre Crouch's "I'll Be Thinking Of You." The song was selected as a thematic introduction, correlated with the hymns and the concept is based on actual events in Christie's childhood.

A Los Angeles native, Christie's labor of love began with a \$300 saxophone purchased at a local pawn shop in Houston, Texas, where she attended the renowned High School of Performing and Visual Arts. She is a graduate of Houston Baptist University, degree in Music and Social Work.
