Top-Selling Christian Singer To Headline At State Fair

One of gospel music's hottest stars is joining the eclectic lineup for this year's Oregon State Fair concert series. Carman, who has sold 7 million albums and videos, is expected to draw one of the biggest crowds of the year to the LB Day Amphitheater when he performs Friday, September 4th at 7 pm.

Tickets go on sale Friday, July 24 at 8 am and are available at all Fred Meyer Fastix outlets and at Music Millennium. Portland area residents can charge by phone at

224-8499. Others can call toll free at 1-800-992-8499. If purchased by August 26, tickets are \$10 and \$15 for adults; \$7 and \$12 for senior; \$6 and \$11 for children ages 6-12; and \$5 and \$10 for children 5 and under. After August 26, prices go up by \$1 for adults and \$2 for seniors and children.

Carman released his 14th album, *Mission 3:16*, in January. It hasn't been off the Top Ten Christian Music charts since. Like five of his previous albums, this one seems destined to

earn at least Platinum status. Carman is in the early part of two year focus on *Mission 3:16*, which he calls his boldest and most creative effort to date. Based in Nashville, Carman attracts attention throughout the country. He was a big draw when he performed at the LB Day Amphitheater in 1993 and holds the record for drawing the largest crowd ever to a Christian concert. 71,000 fans packed Texas Stadium in 1994 to see him.

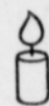

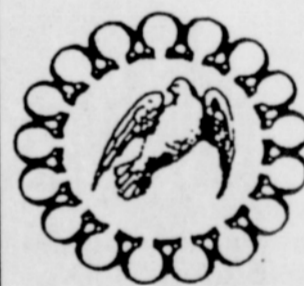
