The Temptations New Album and NBC Mini-Series Airs November 1 & 2

The mighty, mighty Temptations, keepers of the original Motown Sound, released their critically acclaimed 36th album, **The Temptations Phoenix Rising** on August 18, 1998.

On November 1 & 2 1998, the Temptations will be honored with a NBC docu-drama mini-series on the story behind the Temptations. The television docu-drama is currently being filmed in Pittsburgh.

The Temptations Phoenix Rising contains the group's new hit single, "Stay" which boldly features a well-placed sample of the Temptations' classic "My Girl."

All across the country "Stay" is one of the most requested songs on the radio. Radio audience to date is well over 11 million and growing rapidly. The video is in rotation on VH1 and BET.

Today, the Temptations are still on the road with first/second tenor Otis Williams, the only remaining original member, joined by four excellent vocalists; Ron Tyson, first tenor; Barrington Henderson, baritone; Terry Weeks, first/second tenor and baritone; and Harry McGilberry, bass.

Indeed the current line up holds the circle of time in their hands and

hearts as they hold the microphones in the name of one of the most beloved group of men ever to step up into history's footsteps.

The groups in and of itself deserved the admiration of the tireless, since their touring schedule runs into hundreds of performance dates totaling over 40 weeks each year.

In January 1998, the group performed during Super Bowl XXXII half-time as part of the special show dedicated to Motown's 40th Anniversary.

In addition, Williams, was featured in Motown 40: the Music Lives Forever, a 2-part ABC documentary on Motown that aired February 1998.

Over the years, the Temptations have had an amazing 43 Top 10 R&B singles, 14 #1 R&B singles, 15 Top 10 Pop singles, 4 #1 Pop singles and a total of 4 Grammy Awards.

The Temptations, the world's number one soul group, are still mentors. By creating music as timeless as the cuts on **The Temptations Phoenix Rising**. The Temptations will be doing the Temptations Walk well into the year 2000.

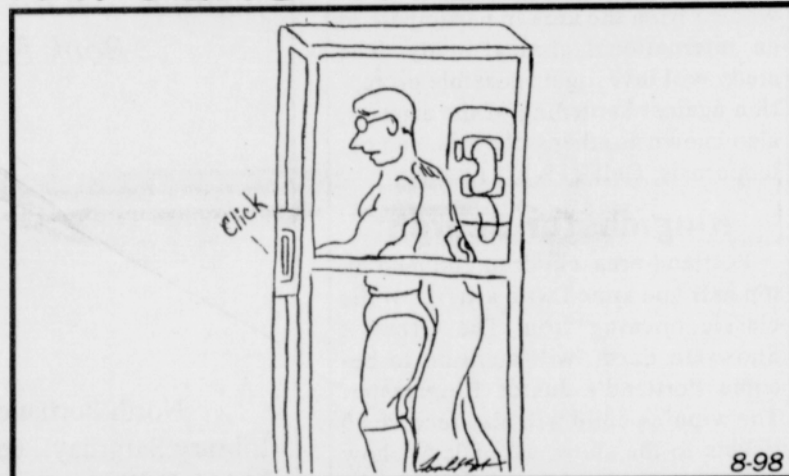
The Other Woman features an impressive list of producers and artist cameos.
