Advertisement For Bids

Sealed bids for the construction of the City of Turner Sanitary Sewer Collection System Project will be received by the City of Turner, 7250 N. 3rd Street, Turner, OR 97392, until 7:00 P.M. Pacific Daylight time on October 8, 1998. Bids will be opened publicly and read aloud in the Turner Fire Hall, 7605 3rd Street, Turner, Oregon, at 7:00 P.M. on October 8, 1998. Bids shall be labeled "Bids for the City of Turner Sanitary Sewer Construction Project".

The work includes the furnishing of the labor, materials, and equipment for the construction of: 44,800 L.F. of gravity sewer pipes sizes 8" to 21", 16,700 L.F. of pressure sewer main, 4 pump stations, private sewer laterals, as well as other miscellaneous work necessary for the City of Turner, Oregon. The estimated cost range for this project is \$7 to 8 million.

Bidders shall comply with all requirements of ORS Chapter 279 and any other applicable sections of the Oregon Revised Statutes. BOLI Wage Rates are applicable to this project.

Each bid must contain a statement as to whether the bidder is a resident bidder as defined in ORS 279.029. Registration with the Construction Contractor's Board as required by ORS 710.055 is a prerequisite to bidding this Project. Prequalification will not be required for this project.

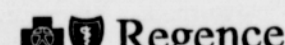
