Chris Tucker (left) and Jackie Chan (right) star in New Line Cinema's action-comedy, *Rush Hour*.

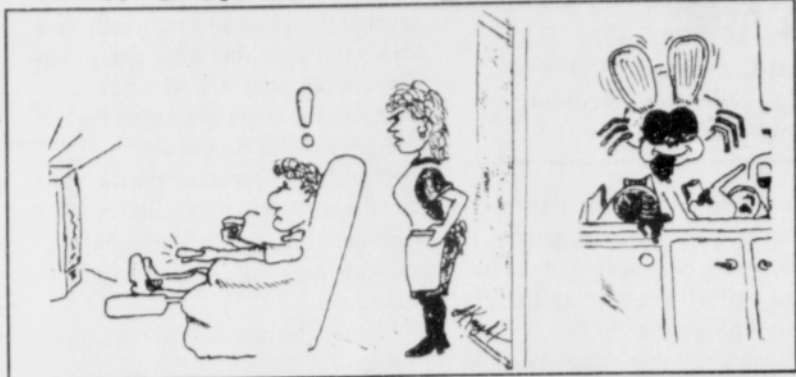
The fastest hands in the East meets the biggest mouth in the West when martial arts legend Jackie Chan pairs with comedic powerhouse Chris Tucker in "Rush Hour," which opened in theaters on September 18th.

Jackie Chan takes on his first

starring role in an American film in more than 12 years, and Chris Tucker re-team with "Money Talks" director, Bret Ratner. Detective Inspector Lee (Chan) is the pride of the Royal Hong Kong Police—a cop whose modest demeanor gives no hint that he is also a martial arts genius. His

assignment: go to the states and rescue an eleven year old girl for whom he is bodyguard and friend, when she is kidnapped by the criminal mastermind who killed Lee's partner. The FBI assigns rogue LAPD Detective James Carter (Tucker) to the case. He enthusiastically takes it on—until

he discovers that his mission is to "baby-sit" Lee and keep him away from the investigation at any cost. In a move that is vintage Carter, he covertly embarks on a one-man crusade to solve the case. Of course, first he must distract Inspector Lee. "Rush Hour" is rated PG-13.

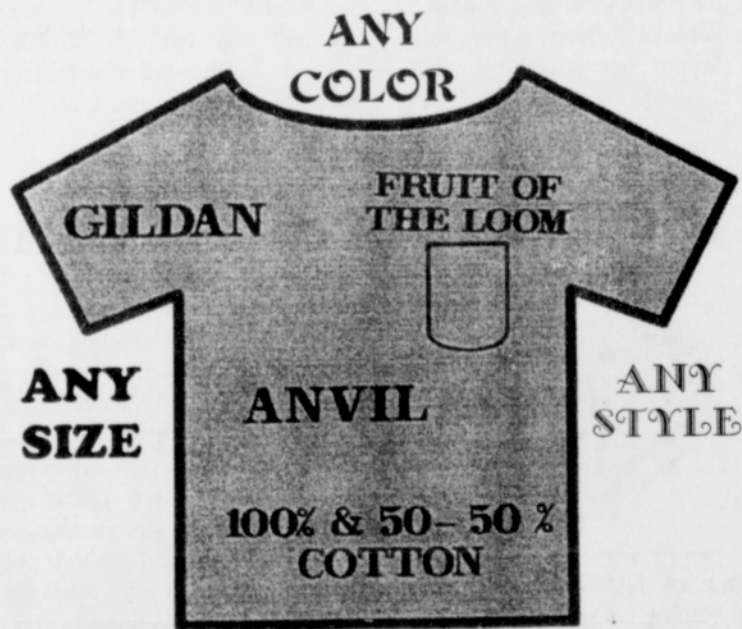

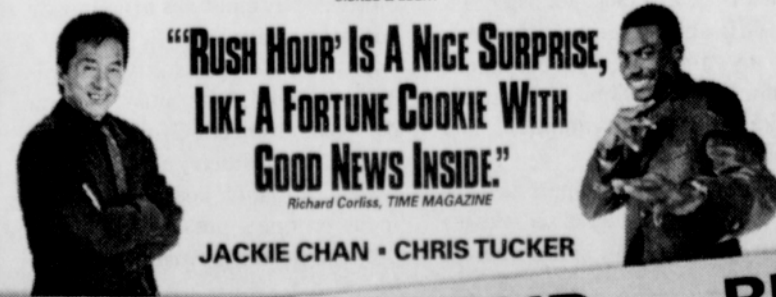
