Munroe Lee Allen

Friend attended the services of Munroe Lee Allen on September 11, 1998 at the Community Church of God.

Munroe was born on December 1, 1936 in Atlanta, Texas to Isaac E. and Geneva R. (Jenkins) Allen. He passed away in San Francisco, California at the Veterans Hospital of pancreatic infection on September 4, 1998 at the age of 61.

Mr. Allen was member of the Community Church of God in Portland. He had also been a cook and was a historian. He lived in Portland for many years and has only lived in San Francisco, Ca. for the past 2 years.

Mrs. Jessie Marie Floyd was born in Warren, Arkansas on August 5, 1909, she's lived in Portland since 1943 and was a production worker for N.W. Packing Cannery and a member of the Mt. Sinai Community Baptist Church.

She passed on at the age of 89 on September 12, 1998 here, in Portland.

She is the only nationally recorded female Christian saxophonist in the world. She is a Stellar Award nominee. She has ministered before both civic and religious leaders. She has traveled to Africa, England, Germany and a myriad of destinations. She has successfully established a 12-year full time music ministry and has garnered both prominence and copious media coverage. And now she presents her second, national release, *Hymn & i* (AIR-Gospel).

She is Angella Christie.

Hymn & i A masterpiece

Every selection a testimony. Every verse a trial. Every chorus a triumph. Every reprise a pledge of allegiance to the Creator. Every vamp an affirmation of faith.

Hymn & i, the hymnal of Angella's life, is a musical glimpse into an intimate relationship' it is an 11-hymn compilation of many of the classic songs of the church. Subject to Angella's dulcet sound and passionate, yet reverent interpretation, these canticle selections conjoin the songs and sounds of generations past and present while influencing the standard of gospel music for the millennium. "My hope for *Hymn & i* is to reach the masses by masterfully performing our music, the songs of the church. It is my contribution toward reclaiming and introducing standard songs to a new generation."

"The Model Prayer," "Love Lifted Me" and "Blessed Assurance"

are but a few of the hymns and spiritual songs presented in this highly anticipated classic. *Hymn & i* displays Angella's musical maturity and versatility from sacred sounds to contemporary techniques. In the coeval credence of Solid Rock", and the stirring balladry of "I Surrender All" as well as the traditional declaration of "Great is thy Faithfulness," and the urban remix of "Walk With Me," each song reflects Angella's most precious memories, experiences and encounters with the Father.

Recorded live (at her home church, New Birth Missionary Baptist Church - Bishop Eddie L. Long, Sr. Pastor) and in studio, *Hymn & i* is accompanied by a concept video, "I'll Be Thinking of U," a remake of an Andre Crouch classic. The song, though not a hymn, was included on the CD as a project compendium. "I'll Be Thinking of U," as you will see in the video, is a reminder of all the times that God has looked out for me. I felt that it tied in so well with the project because each hymn is one that I played during a major test or lesson in my life and every time God thought of me and brought me through."

Angella again sits in the co-producer seat next to producer Ryck Carter, who also produced "Eternity," her first national project. "Overall, *Hymn & i* is me. It expresses me musically as well as spiritually. The entire project has meaning and significance."
