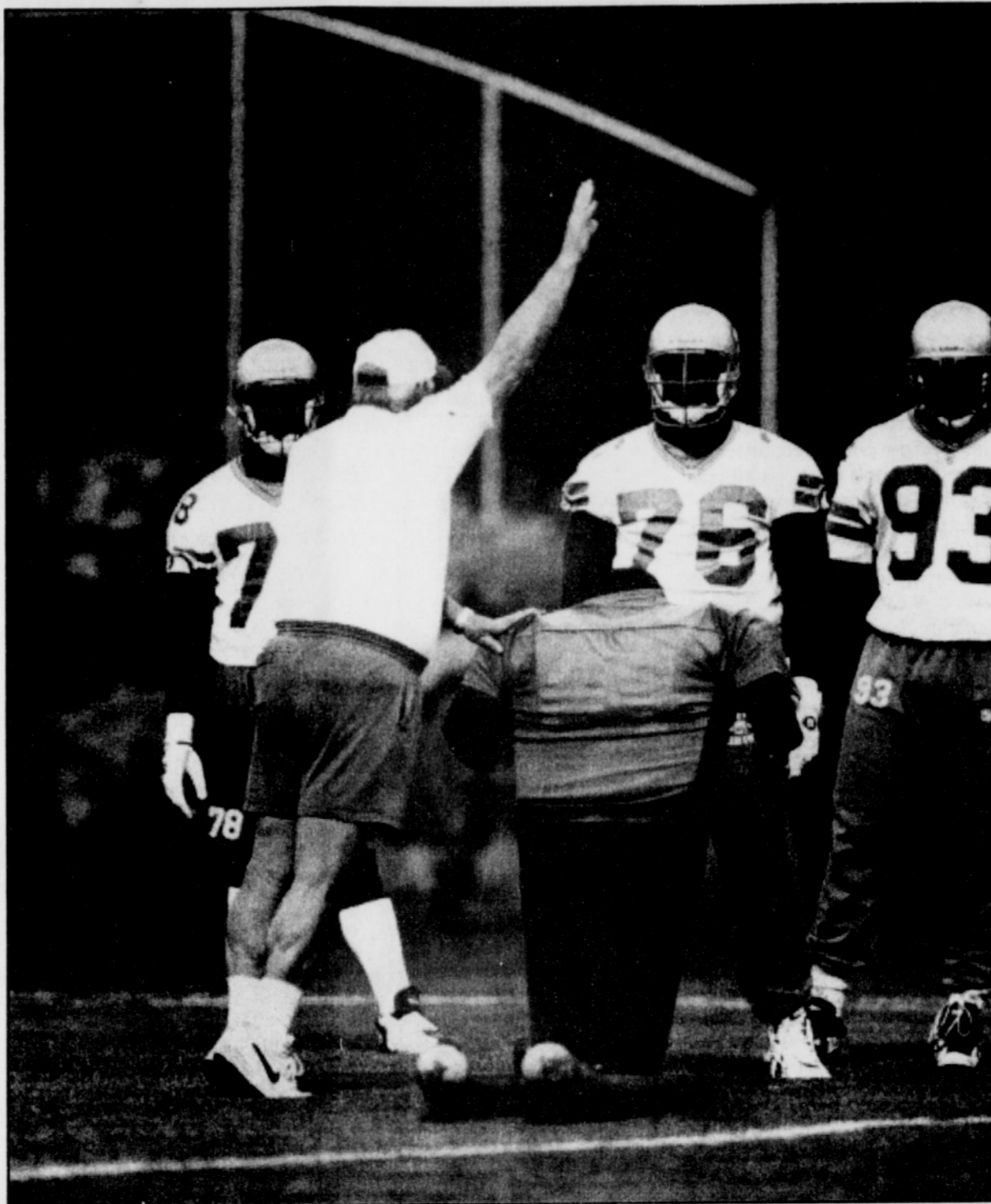

The Seattle Seahawks nurse Playoff Hopes

The Seattle Seahawks might be trudging toward a 10th straight season without a playoff berth, but Springs wants to play one more game after the New Year. The second-year corner back feels he deserves a trip to Hawaii as much anyone else, and it's difficult to argue with him.

Springs has returned two of his five interceptions for touchdowns, and came within a broken tackle of running back a third. He has broken up 15 passes. He has allowed only one touchdown pass to be completed against him in the first 12 games. In Sunday's victory over the Tennessee Oilers, Spring allowed only one pass to be completed against him, a 5-yarder.

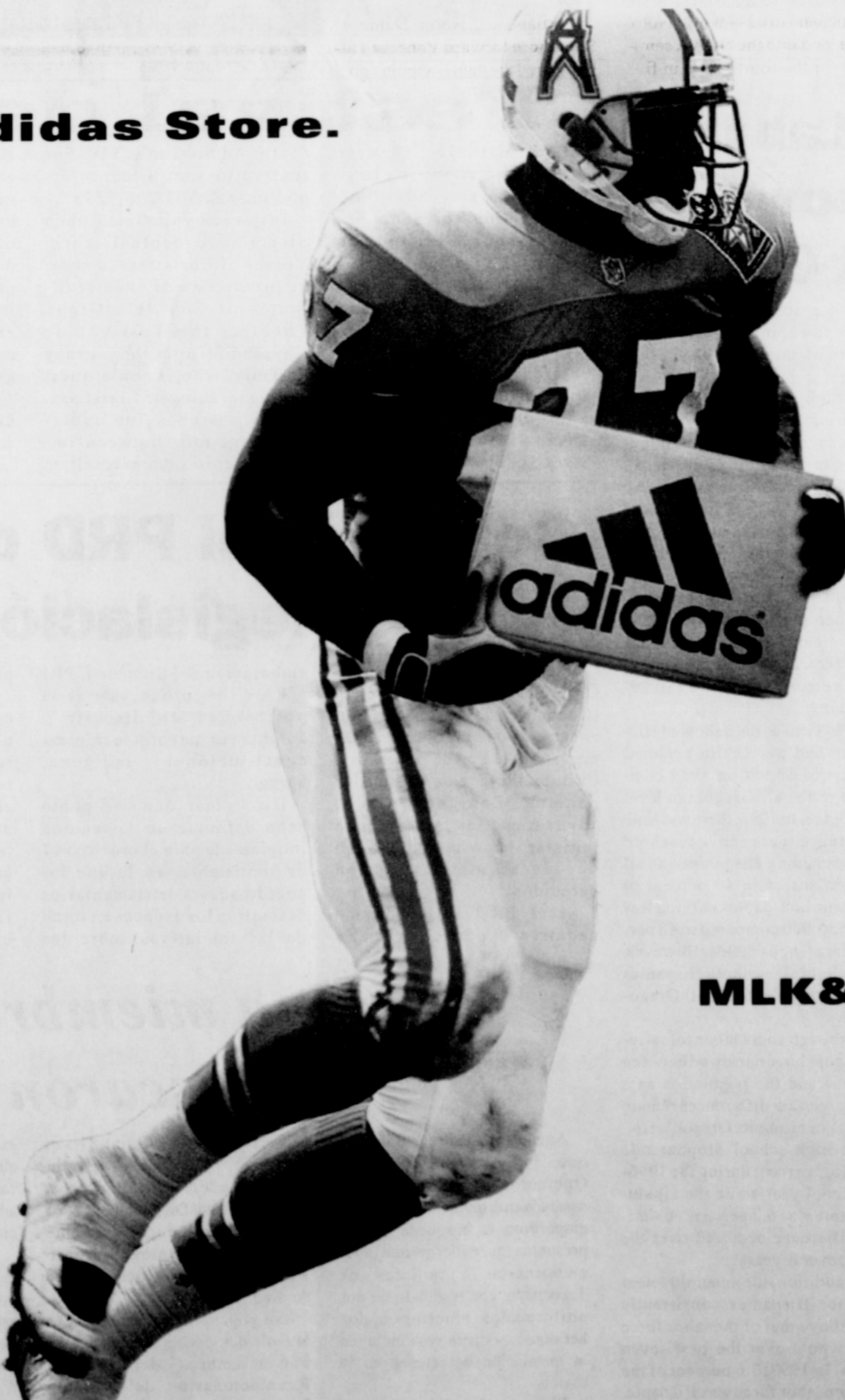
The reason Springs has taken to stumping for votes is that he realizes he has several things working against him.

First, there is the overall disappointment of this season for the Seahawks, who are 6-6. Then, there is the fact that the defense is ranked in the bottom third of the league, a misleading statistic because the big-play unit has kept the Seahawks in almost every game they have lost—in four of their six losses, the Seahawks could have won or tied the game by scoring on their final possession.

History also is working against Springs, since only one corner back in club history has been voted to the Pro Bowl—Dave Brown in 1984. Recent history hasn't been kind to Springs either, because his touchdown returns came in the first two games of the season, and against NFC opponents.

But Springs is the one player who is standing out in an otherwise undistinguished secondary. He knows he needs another big play or two in this week's game against the New York Jets at the Meadowlands to help produce a late flurry of votes just before balloting by players and coaches for the Pro Bowl...
