"We've worked hard to keep a target on the number of jobs in north and northeast Portland, and we know we have to work harder. This area hasn't always benefitted from the good times the rest of the city has enjoyed."

"This is the most significant development proposal the city has seen in 10 years," Sten said. adidas Portland business unit manager Ray Leary added, "It's a tremendous vote of confidence that adidas would make north and northeast Portland their national headquarters. It shows that businesses in northeast Portland can succeed."

Overlook Neighborhood Association chair Bob Peterson said the decision "will be great for the neighborhood, and the whole city will benefit."

Peterson added that the process for selecting a new use for the hospital was a tribute to Kaiser Permanente and the developer they chose, James Winkler, after their decision to remove their own operations. "The neighborhood was

involved every step of the way," he said. "It was an example of how the process should work."

In the process of rezoning the property for institutional (IR) to neighborhood office (CO2) use last year, the city at Kaiser and the neighborhood's request added a design overlay that will require a public review of adidas' plans.

Former Overlook chair Sandi Hansen added, "Kaiser asked us, 'What should replace the hospital?' We told them, and they listened. Our concerns had to be addressed (by potential users) because they were in the RFP (request for proposals). I can't tell you how unusual that is."

As for Winkler she said, "I can't adopt him and I can't marry him. I wish I could."

Wynne credited Winkler's "diligence" for adidas' decision. At first, "The idea of relocating to a former hospital was...interesting," Wynne quipped.

Winkler in turn credited Kaiser.

"They didn't look at this as just the resale of a surplus asset or recycling writ large," he said. "This is a model of what urban development should be....I'm inspired by Kaiser's example, and honored to carry the torch to the finish."

Ironically, Winkler is now working on a project to develop a new factory outlet store on Northeast Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard at Russell Street for adidas rival Nike. He also built 42 row houses subdivision on adjacent land east of the Nike site. Last week, with 39 of the houses sold, he turned the property over to the new owners.

The praise heaped on Kaiser last week was a far cry from the public reaction in 1995. Its decision to close the hospital was attacked as a betrayal of the community and its own employees. In contrast, last week Wynne said of Kaiser, "From the time it came here to the time it left it was a model corporate citizen. It's a standard we aspire to."
