

MLK's Birthday Launches Peace Concert and CD

One day after the anniversary of Martin Luther King, Jr.'s birthday, a non-violence awareness campaign inspired inpart by the civil rights leader will kickoff with a benefit concert and c.d. release.

On January 16, 1999, nationally-recognized composer/ pianist Michael Allen Harrison, along with musicians Aaron Meyer, Bill Lamb, Phil Baker, Israel Annoh and Tim Ellis, will perform selections from a new compact disc entitled "Seasons of Peace." Harrison will also be joined by the 100member Metropolitan Youth Symphony for 6 PM and 8:30 PM performances at Wilsonville's Living Enrichment Center (29500 SW Grahams Ferry Road). Available for the first time during the concerts, the c.d. features original music Harrison.

The concert and c.d. benefit the international grass roots

peace initiative, A Season for Nonviolence. After an official start at the United Nations on January 29, organizers will launch projects in more than 100 U.S. cities and ten countries. In the Portland area, activities include a speakers fo-



rum, featuring guests such as Arun Gandhi, a peace walk and an educational web-site located at SeasonPDX@aol.com.

A Season for Nonviolence Task Force chair Ana DeMers explains that projects like the benefit concert and c.d. "help people appreciate the importance of even the smallest steps in creating a more peaceful world."


