**Extranet Certification and Tracking Database
for Manufactured Homes**

Deadline: April 9, 1999

The Oregon Office of Energy invites proposals from qualified
consultants to design, develop and implement a new database
management system and extranet to be used for automated certification
and tracking for the Super Good Cents/Natural Choice Manufactured
Homes Program. This database system is to be integrated with an
extranet based on using Web browser and Web server technology to
communicate with home manufacturers and dealers. The selected
contractor will develop and install the new system including the central
server hardware, database software and application interface for
remote sites.

The initial term of the contract is estimated to be two years, with an
option to renew for an additional year. The amount for the first year of
the initial contract is expected to be approximately \$75,000. The
amounts for the second and third years are not known, but may be as
much as \$60,000 per year. The Office of Energy reserves the right to
amend the original contract, including increases in the amount and
other changes which may be necessary to complete the project. In
addition, the selected contractor(s) may be retained under separate
contract(s) to perform similar work for Idaho and Washington states
if the program is expanded into those states.

The Office of Energy has scheduled a pre-proposal meeting Thursday,
March 18, 1999 at 10 AM. The meeting will take place at the Salem
office of the Office of Energy, 625 Marion Street NE. This meeting is
not mandatory. The Office of Energy does not intend to publish a
