

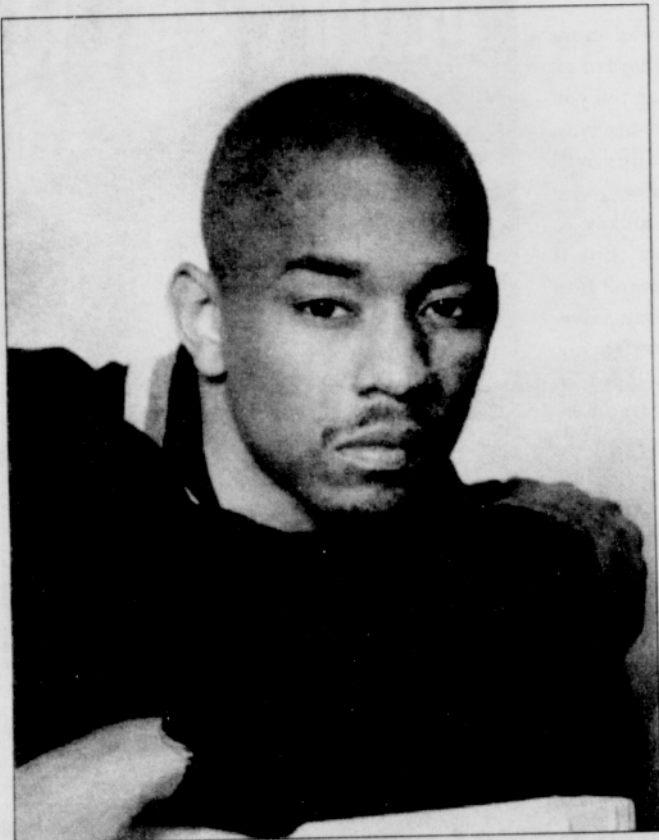

LIFE

Eddie Murphy and Martin Lawrence star in *Life*, an endearing comedy from Universal Pictures and Imagine Entertainment. Co-starring Obba Babatundé (*That Thing You Do!*), Ned Beatty, Clarence Williams III (*Hoodlum*, *Half Baked*), Cicely Tyson and Bernie Mac, the film reunites Murphy with Brian Grazer, the producer of his 1996 smash hit comedy, *The Nutty Professor*. Ted Demme (*Beautiful Girls*, *the Ref*) is the film's director.

Ray (Murphy) and Claude (Lawrence) are two men who are wrongly convicted of murder and sentenced to life imprisonment at a Mississippi penitentiary. Over the course of 60 years, they witness hardship and kindness, cruelty and forgiveness, life and death. But their humorous way of looking at life prevails as their friendship deepens and endures, and the pair never lose hope that one day, somehow, they will walk outside the prison walls as free men.
