Latin Madness Big Band Returns May 2 To Benson

"Latin Madness 2, Presented by YOUR LOCAL COMPLETE WIRELESS CENTER," returns to the Benson Hotel at 7 PM Sunday, May 2.

The dance/concert, fourth in a series of jazz-related "Madness" events produced by John Wendeborn, will feature a 20-piece Latin orchestra playing music spanning the '40s and '50s, sounds that originated with the bands of Machito, Perez-Prado, Mario Bauza, Tito Puente and Tito Rodriguez.

Also performing will be premier Portland-area band Pa'lante. As an added attraction, the five-drum ensemble Conga Fideles will entertain with a spirited trip through percus-

sion land.

"Latin Madness 2, Presented by YOUR LOCAL COMPLETE WIRELESS CENTER," will be in the Benson Hotel's Mayfair Room. Food and bar service will be available in the room. The May 2 event, celebrating Cinco de Mayo (May 5), repeats last year's Latin Madness sellout show.
