She also choreographed several works for Seabury Preparatory School in Makawao, Hawaii, as well as taught master classes in Kneeland Methodology throughout the country. Stepping out of directorships, she performs occasionally. She enjoyed playing "Sheila" in A Chorus Line with The Musical Theatre Company.
