Cinco de Mayo showcases Mexican food, music, dance, and Latin rhythms featuring popular Mexican and Hispanic artists and groups, including Guadalajara's internationally famous Folk Ballet, the Grupo Folklorico de Guadalajara, and the Guadalajara Mariachi Band.

In addition to the Children's, Merchants and Artisan Plazas will be the greatly expanded "La Plaza Mercado" reminiscent of a typical

town in Mexico where merchants sell their wares, and just as in Mexico, authentic artisans demonstrate and sell their hand-crafted art work.

Add to all of this the family carnival, Fireworks Spectacular, Naturalization Ceremony, Mariachi Mass, and much more, and guests will see why Sister Cities International, headquartered in Washington D.C. representing over 3,200 chapters with affiliations in 125 countries, the President of the United States is their Honorary Chair, awarded the Portland-Guadalajara Sister City Association their 1998 Collaboration Award.
