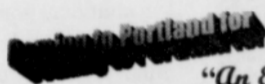

Pope Salutes Kosovo Refugees

VATICAN CITY (AP) — Pope John Paul II saluted Kosovo refugees among the pilgrims gathered Sunday in St. Peter's Square, saying he was praying for peace.

Speaking to a crowd of thousands, the pale-looking pope singled out what he said was a large group of Kosovo refugees, guests of Italian charities.

"Dear brothers, in this month of May, we are praying particularly for peace," the pontiff said. "The intercession of the Blessed Mary will obtain it for you and for all the peoples tortured by war."

John Paul has made repeated appeals for an end to all fighting over Kosovo, and the Vatican has tried and failed to help broker a peace accord.

Sunday's homily was devoted to charity workers, whom he called examples of love "in our world, so distracted and indifferent."

The Sunday greetings to pilgrims are a seldom-missed routine of the pope, who marks his 79th birthday on Tuesday.
