Flashing back to the twentysomething trio's childhood exploits, the film captures the mood and nostalgia of the '80s era through the powerful beats and lyrics of some of the decade's most memorable hip-hop music.

Mike (Omar Epps) and Slim (Richard T. Jones) never thought they'd see the day their man Roland (Taye Diggs) would strut down the aisle to get married. Neither, apparently, did Roland, who ducks out just hours before the ceremony and turns up at the house of his high school sweetheart, Tanya (Tamala Jones). Though he adores his fiancée (Lisaraye), Roland sees the impending nuptials as a separation from those who have always been closest to him, his neighborhood partners from Inglewood, which they fondly refer to as the Wood.


