### Drug-Related **Deaths** Jump

The State Medical Examiner's Office has released new statistics showing a 56% increase in drug-related deaths from the first half of last year.

Figures show 148 such deaths in the same time period this year. Heroin, the leading cause of drugrelated deaths, has seen an increase of 75% from last year.

Cocaine use remains the second-leading killer and is up nearly 110% from last year.
