Sharon Pratt Kelly defied great odds on November 6, 1990, to become the first female leader of the nation's capitol, and the first African-American woman to serve as mayor of a major urban city. Mrs. Kelly served as Mayor of the major urban city.

Mrs. Kelly is a native Washington, who attended District of Columbia public schools. She furthered her education at Howard University. Earning a BA with honors in political science in 1965 and a Juris doctorate from Howard University Law School in 1968. Mrs. Kelly's professional career includes serving as an instructor at the Antiosh School of Law, Vice-Chair of the D.C. Law Revision Commission, vice President of the Potomac Electric Power Company, and terms as the Democratic National Committeewoman from the District of Columbia.

Mrs. Kelly has been active in her community all of her life. She has been a member of the Legal Aid Society, Howard University Board of Trustees; St. Mary's College Board of Trustees, and the Washington Bar Association. Mrs. Kelly is a life member of the Alpha Kappa Alpa Sorority, Inc. Among the local and national awards Mrs. Kelly has received-W.E.B Du Bois Ward, presented by the Congressional Black Caucus, the Ebony Magazine Award, the Thurgood Marshall Award of Excellence, and the NAACP Award. Mrs. Kelly has also been bestowed honorary degrees.


