## State seeking public opinion regarding assessment and investigation of child abuse in Oregon

The Oregon Department of human services is seeking comment from the public about the effectiveness of the state's investigative, administrative and judicial handling of child abuse. A series of four public hearing is scheduled beginning November 18 in Pendleton.

The others will be in Portland, Salem and Medford.

The Oregon Children's Justice Act Task Force, an advisory group appointed by the director of the States Office for services to Children and Families, is completing its system review. Every three years, the task force must evaluate the state's handling of child abuse, neglect and exploitation cases and child maltreatment-related fatalities. Members of the CJATF include judges, law enforcement representatives, child advocates, health care professionals, child protective services specialists, child disability specialists, parents, Citizen Review Board representatives, assessment and advocacy centers and legislators.

The CJATF was established in 1988 to comply with requirements of the Child Abuse Prevention and

Treatment Act. In order to receive funding under this federal act, the state must establish and maintain a multidisciplinary task force on children's Justice.
