Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be held by the Tri-County Metropolitan Transportation District of Oregon (Tri-Met) in Mezzanine Rooms 3 and 4 (Second Floor), Two World Trade Center, 121 S.W. Salmon, Portland at 8:00 - 10:00 AM on Wednesday, December 8th, 1999. The purpose of this hearing is to invite participation in a community-wide public forum to discuss the allocation of new state funding for elderly and disabled transportation services.

The purpose of the forum is to receive public and community comment on how to best allocate new state funding for elderly and disabled transportation services in the Portland metropolitan area.

The 1999 Oregon Legislature approved expanded funding for elderly and disabled transportation services. A portion of the new funds will be allocated to Tri-Met and the greater Portland area. Over the next two years, the region could receive up to approximately \$7 million in capital and operating funds to improve and expand elderly and disabled transportation

The Elderly and Disabled Transportation Forum is being held to receive public and community comments on the expenditure of these new state funds and on the need for additional elderly and disabled transit services. Tri-Met invites the public, agency representatives, community and social service providers and others interested in elderly and disabled transportation issues and services to attend and participate on the forum.
