Request for Proposals #99-37 City of Portland, Oregon Portland Development Commission **Maddox Building** Arts Facility Feasibility Study

The Portland Development Commission ("PDC"), in partnership with the Regional Arts and Culture Council ("RACC"), is seeking proposals from a multi-disciplinary consulting team ("Consultant") to provide services in facility design, market research, and real estate economics'. The selected Consultant will prepare an economic feasibility analysis that evaluates the development of the Maddox Building as a muti purpose arts facility.

The Maddox Building, a two story, 80,000 square foot, concrete warehouse located at 49 SE Clay Street, Portland, Oregon, has the potential to become an important public attractor for the Eastside Riverfront Project, which PDC and the Portland Bureau of Parks and Recreation currently have in Phase III of development.

The feasibility analysis will be conducted in collaboration with a broadbased citizen advisory committee. The Consultant will identify programmatic models that best meet the objectives of the arts and the community, have a high likelihood to draw people to the area, and require the minimum amount of public assistance. All models should have design continuity with all phases of the Eastside Riverfront Project and may incorporate the needs of a light watercraft center currently proposed in the Eastbank Riverfront Master Plan.

PDC invites consultants to submit proposals addressing the requirements identified in the Request for Proposals (RFP). The proposals shall be responsive to the format, scope of work and submittal requirements described in the RFP.
