

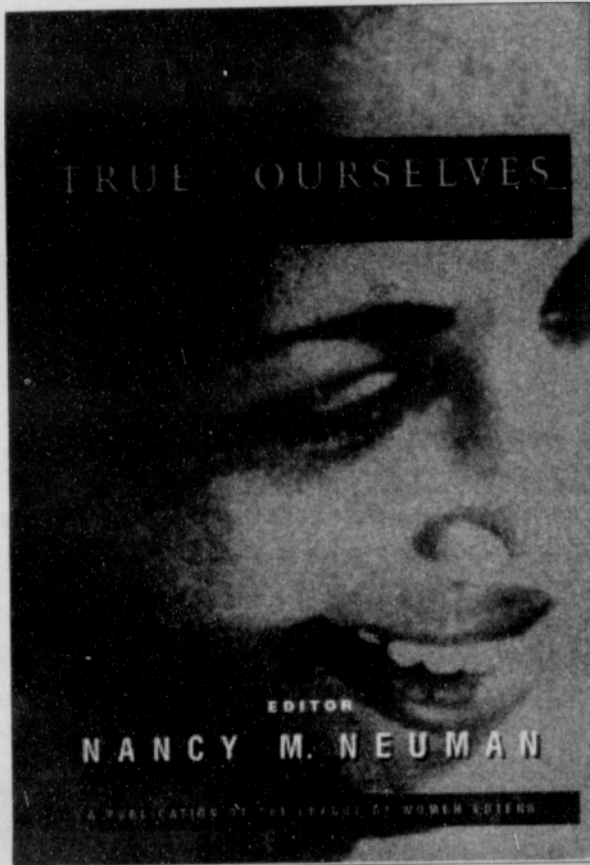

To coincide with this anniversary, the League of Women Voters sponsored the publication of a remarkable book by, and about, American women—*True To Ourselves: A Celebration of Women Making a Difference*. A unique collection of essays written by 22 American women from diverse backgrounds, this book provides an exceptional portrait of the immense influence and expanding power of women in public life during the second half of the twentieth century. From the enormously influential New York Congresswoman Bella Abzug who died two years ago, to the first woman to reach the North and South Poles, Ann Bancroft, to the tenacious Oregon governor, Barbara Roberts — the women in *True To Ourselves* tell stories of real people whose dreams and disappointments will be recognized by a wide range of readers. Each essay illustrates the book's central theme: that women are truly measured by their day-to-day commitment to something larger than themselves.
