Sealed bids for the Portland International Airport, Runway and Taxiway Improvements 2000 project will be received at the office of the Manager, Contracts and Procurement, of The Port of Portland, 121 N.W. Everett Street, 5th Floor, Portland, Oregon 97209, (503) 944-7593 (mailing address: Post Office Box 3529, Portland, Oregon 97208) until, but not after, 3 p.m. April 25, 2000, and thereafter publicly opened and read.

Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Program: Bidders are required to show that small subcontractors, suppliers, or manufacturers which have been specifically designated by the Oregon State Office of Minority, Women, and Emerging Small Business as a disadvantaged business enterprise ("DBE") will participate in not less than 17 percent of the total dollar amount bid.

Description of Work: Overlay the south half of Runway 3-21 and portions of three taxiways, reconstruct a portion of one taxiway, widen four exit taxiways, and relocate an existing perimeter road utilizing asphalt concrete; remove and reinstall runway and taxiway edge lights, taxiway centerline lights, and in-pavement runway guard lights; excavate, fill, grade, and seed runway and taxiway shoulders; install a new storm sewer system along both sides of Runway 3; and groove the finished runway surface.
