The Evergreen Fisheries Park is a facility that provides fish production, environmental education and fisheries science, in addition to providing local passive recreation opportunities. Vancouver-Clark Parks & Recreation Services, Clark Public Utilities, and Washington Department of Fish & Wildlife (WDFW) are partners in the first phase improvements. Proposed improvements include: parking, trails, shelter, accessible fishing dock, restroom, interpretive signing, viewpoints, benches, tables, bike racks, play area and landscaping.
