Rating: R, for strong violence, some sexuality, language and brief drug content.

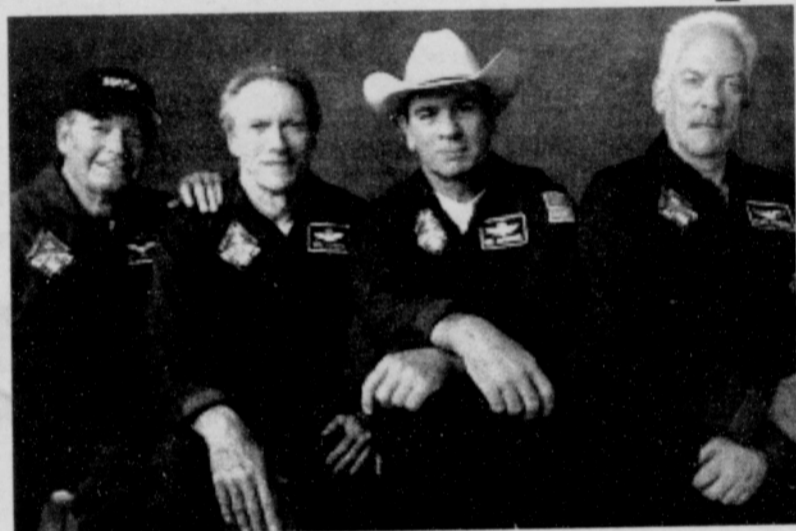
