Central Puget Sound Regional Transit Authority Invitation For Bid (IFB) NO. RTA/LR 61-00: Construction of Tacoma Link Light Rail Segment

The Central Puget Sound Regional Authority (Sound Transit) will receive bids until 2:00 p.m., Seattle time, on August 16, 2000, at Sound Transit, Contracts Division, 401 S Jackson Street, Seattle, Washington 98104-2826 for the above referenced solicitation. As soon as practicable after said time and date, bids properly received will be publicly opened and read in the Board Room, located on the First Floor of Sound Transit's Offices (Union Station). Bidders accept all risks of late delivery, regardless of fault.

A Bid Bond, certified check, or money order payable to Sound Transit in the amount of five percent (5%) of the total bid price must accompany each bid as a Bid Guaranty. The Bid Guaranty of all bidders will be returned after Sound Transit's receipt from the successful bidder of acceptable performance and payment bonds which is to take place after Sound Transit executes a contract with this successful bidder. Bids shall constitute offers to Sound Transit for the work set forth in the IFB document, and shall be binding for 120 days from the date of bid opening.

Contractor's performance and payment bond, issued by a surety registered with the Washington State Insurance Commissioner and a Certificate of Insurance are required. The penal sum of the performance and payment bond shall be equal to 100% of the total price of the awarded contract. The bond and certificate of insurance must be delivered to Sound Transit within fourteen (14) calendar days after Sound Transit notification of the award to the successful bidder. Bond must be approved by the appropriate officials award is final.

A binding contract must be executed and returned to sound Transit within ten (10) calendar days after notification of Contract award.

Sound Transit reserves the right to reject any bid, any portion of any bid and/or to reject all bids. Sound Transit further reserves the right, but without obligation, to waive all informalities and irregularities.

The Work of this Contract is to Construct the Tacoma Link Light Rail Segment which includes and is not limited to: Construction and installation of approximately 1.8 miles of embedded track, construction of five passenger stations, demolition of the 25th Street Bridge, demolition and reconstruction of vaulted sidewalks; reconstruction of streets and sidewalks; utility improvements, street lighting, landscaping, irrigation, and art projects; construction and widening of both asphalt and concrete roadways and parking areas, urban and design work, side street improvements, construction of mechanical facilities including equipment, and use OCS/traffic poles; trackwork including trackslab, embedded track, embedded special trackwork, rail for all main track; and sitework for passenger station, parking lots, and electrical substations.

The Work will also include disposal of waste material, site work, security fencing, and the coordination of the Work with other Sound Transit construction contracts.

The estimated value of this contract is in excess of \$20,000,000
