Consulting services are required to develop and support a public decision-making process and provide support for this process with development of water quality goals and an evaluation of various treatment technologies and sites available to meet water quality goals and description of the project, specific requirements and evaluation criteria for the proposal may be obtained from the Bureau of Water Works, Room 600, 1120 SW Fifth Avenue, Portland, OR 97204, or by calling (503) 823-7404. Proposals shall be received at that office until 2:00 p.m., December 7, 2000.

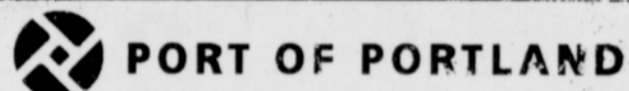

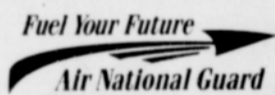
