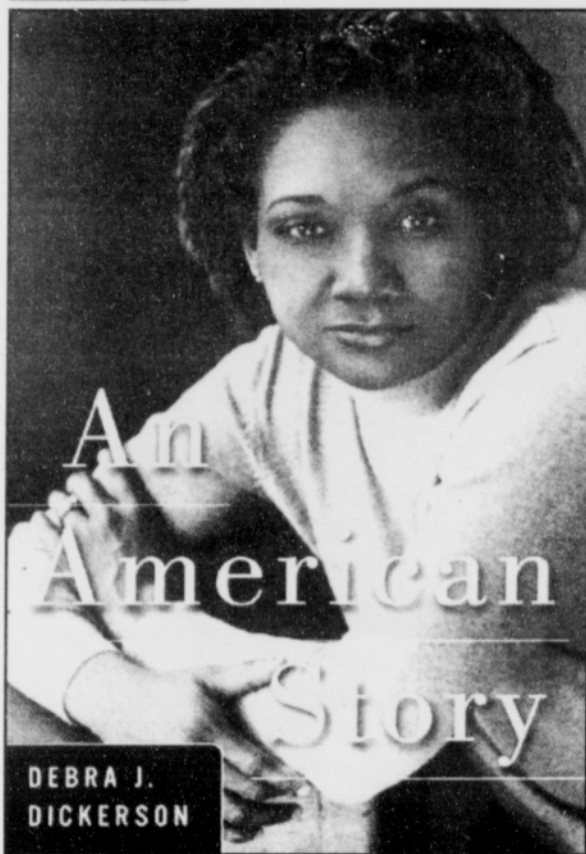


In Print An American Story

Debra Dickerson has lived through several hardships in her forty-one years – physical abuse, poverty, racism, sexism, rape – and has emerged from each traumatic experience a bit

more self-aware, and a great deal stronger.

Today she is a brilliant and outspoken journalist, but the path she followed and what it took to reach this point is both surprising and inspiring. In her memoir, "An American Story" Dickerson unmasks herself, her family, and our society, bearing

witness to her complex, if tumultuous, life as an American.

Were it not for her fierce intelligence and innate toughness, Dickerson might not have made it. She watched other blacks around her – family, friends, neighbors –

lose the battle with drugs, poverty, racism, and what she perceived as a lack of conviction. As a young girl, she never dreamed of the range of experiences life had in store for her. We witness in "An American Story" Dickerson's exhilarating transformation from diligent "A" student, to distinguished Air Force Intelligence Officer and Korean linguist, intense Harvard Law School student, and, finally, successful journalist.

While she suffered from self-doubt every step of the way (her father's negativity having left deep scars), Dickerson was constantly striving toward success without being fully aware of her amazing potential or where it would take her.

Over the course of her life, Debra Dickerson has reinvented herself time and again, and is a woman who transcends stereotypes. She exhibits a kind of quiet heroism, and her memoir will provide a role model for women – black and white – of all ages.

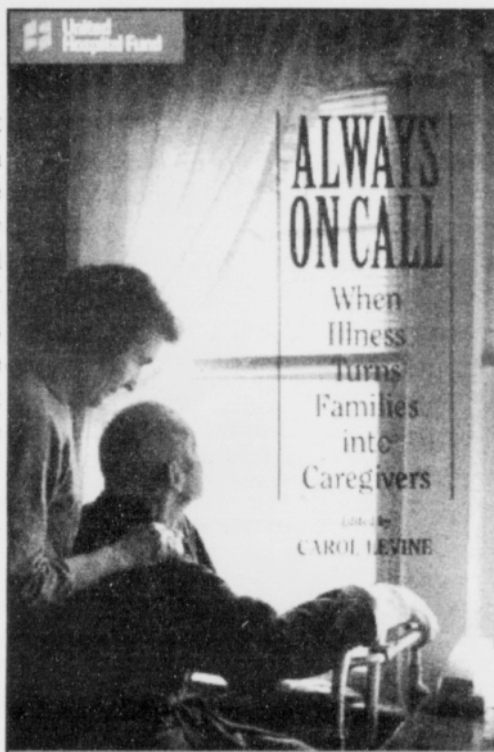
Always On Call
