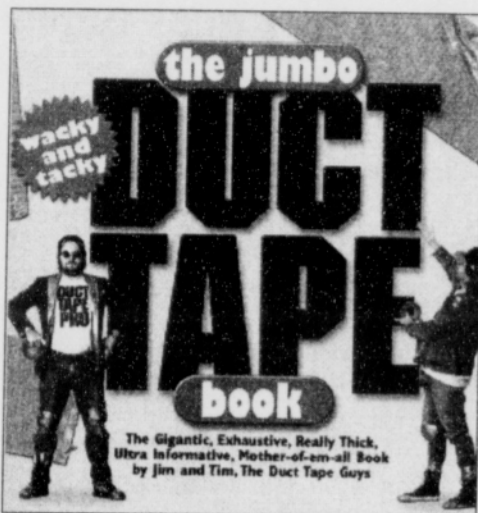

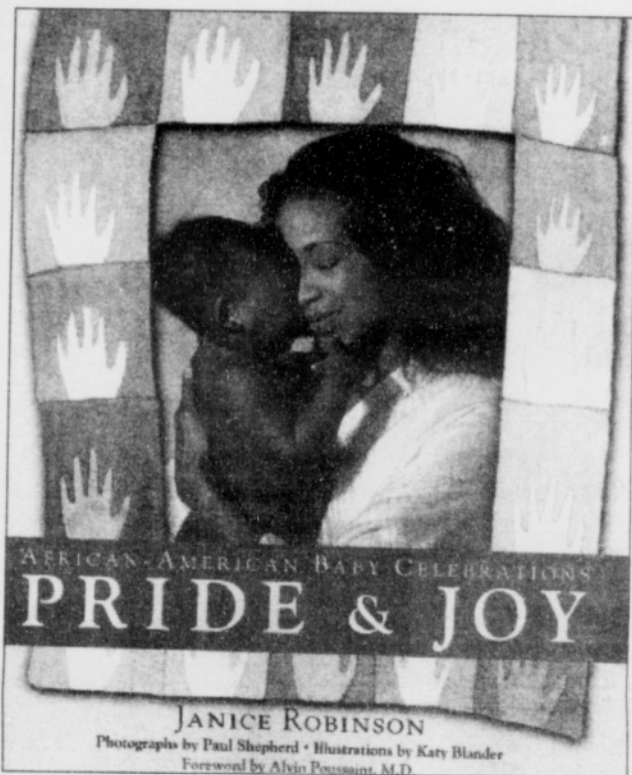
in the car.
