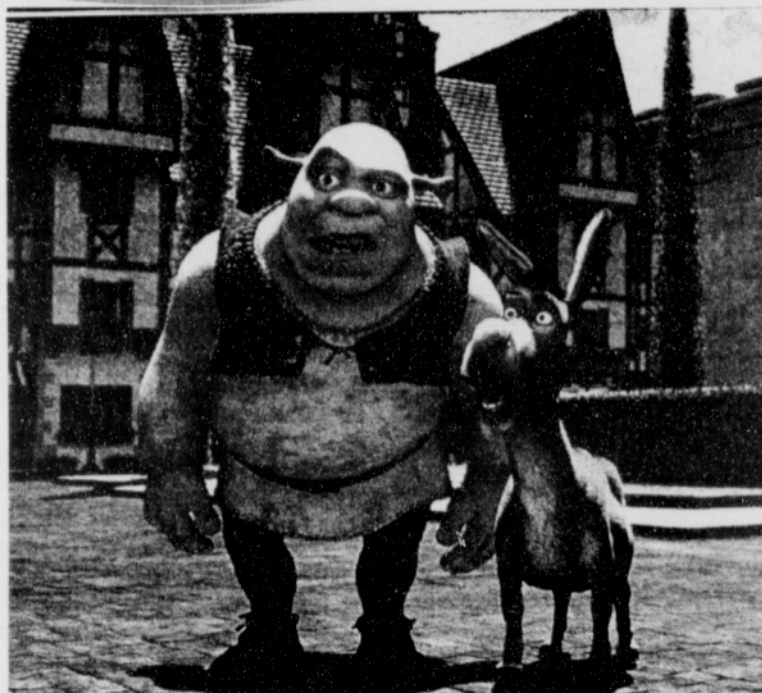


SHREK
