### REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL TO PROVIDE CONSULTING SERVICES FOR THE PARKS & RECREATION DIVISION CITY OF GRESHAM, OREGON

The City of Gresham plans to retain Landscape Architecture consulting services for the Gresham Fairview Trial (CIP Project No. 706200) and the Kelly Creek Greenway Trail services to administer the completion of the Gresham Fairview Trail Master Plan; coordinate locations of Public Access Easements across private properties for the Gresham Fairview Trail; and, provide construction observations and construction administration services for development of the Kelly Creek Greenway Trail. This contract will require 650 hours of Landscape Architect consultant services for the time period July 17, 2001 through January 31, 2002.

Qualifications of Project Personnel. The name, qualifications, and specific work experience of key personnel proposed for this project. Resumes of project staff may be submitted as an Appendix.


