Commemorating 25 years of recording, contemporary jazz legends Spyro Gyra will perform at PGE Park, located at S.W. 20th and Morrison on Jul. 15. The band will perform at 4 p.m. The performance will feature music from the band's fresh new collection, "In Modern Times."

The band's story is one of modern music's most oft-told tales, beginning with Beckenstein a group of leading revolutionaries around the jazz scene circa 1970s.
