

Portland is Jammin' for Salmon

Planning is nearing completion as the Columbia River Inter-Tribal Fish Commission and their sponsors bring "Jammin' for Salmon" - two days of music, art, children's activities, food

and exhibits - to "the Bowl" on the South end of Portland's Tom McCall Waterfront Park, Aug. 4 and 5. The event features five-time Grammy winners, The Robert Cray Band, Chaka Khan, Buckwheat

Zydeco, Indegenous and top local acts. The success of last year's initial "Jammin' for Salmon" on the Umatilla reservation inspired the Commission to bring the event to the Columbia Basin's largest city.

"Jammin' for Salmon" is guided by a vision to celebrate salmon culture in a manner that blends tradition with popular culture and mass communication.

Partnering with the City of Portland and institutions like

OMSI, the Commission expects "Jammin' for Salmon" to become an annual event in the Portland area. In addition to the music, festival-goers can take free jet-boat rides across the Willamette to view salmon-related demonstrations and exhibits at OMSI, and kids can learn about salmon species while playing at the Pacific Power Kids' Power Pavilion.

Food, of course, will be a highlight as traditionally prepared salmon and fry bread

will be available along with an eclectic selection of cuisine.

An added attraction will be an Art Marketplace with Native fine arts and crafts. Twenty artists will display their work offering Portlanders a chance to view and purchase national caliber art.
