OMSI, the Commission expects "Jammin' for Salmon" to become an annual event in the Portland area. In addition to the music, festival-goers can take free jet-boat rides across the Willamette to view salmonrelated demonstrations and exhibits at OMSI, and kids can learn about salmon species while playing at the Pacific Power Kids' Power Pavilion.
