

DHS seeks proposals from communications firms for this contract. The purpose of the contract will be to maintain high visibility for tobacco prevention in Oregon through a combination of earned and paid media. A single contract will be awarded with payments not to exceed \$6 million for a two-year period beginning approximately October 5, 2001.
