You Have The Right to be represented by an attorney at any hearings on the petition regarding the above-named child, to introduce evidence, to be heard on your own behalf, to examine witnesses, to receive a decision based solely on the evidence adduced at the hearing, and to an unbiased fact-finder.

**YOU HAVE THE RIGHT**, if you are indigent and cannot afford an attorney, to have an attorney appointed for you by the court. An attorney can look at the social and legal files in this case, talk to the social worker, tell you about the law, help you understand your rights, and help you at trial.

**YOU MAY BE** responsible for the financial support of the above-named child if the child is placed in out-of-home care.

**YOU SHOULD BE PRESENT AT THIS HEARING.** If you do not come, the judge will not hear what you have to say. If you desire additional information about your child, you should contact the Department of Social and Health Services at (360) 807-7081.

The Department of Human Services (DHS) is issuing a Request for Proposals (RFP) #937 through the Tobacco prevention and Education Program (TPEP) for the continuation, on-going development and implementation of the comprehensive statewide public awareness and education campaign. DHS seeks proposals from communications firms for this contract. The purpose of the contract will be to maintain high visibility for tobacco prevention in Oregon through a combination of earned and paid media.
