Sealed bids for the **WWTP Digester Gas Moisture Removal System, CIP No. 309700** will be received by the Office of the Director of the Department of Environmental Services at Gresham City Hall, 1333 N.W. Eastman Parkway, Gresham, Oregon 97030, until **Friday, November 9, 2001, 9:00 a.m. local time.** The bids will be publicly opened at **1:00 pm on November 9, 2001 in the Springwater Trail Room, City Hall.**

The character of the work is the installation of a filtration system to remove moisture from methane gas produced by anaerobic digesters at the City's wastewater treatment plant, which is used as fuel for the plant's Waukesha CoGeneration Engine.

The major quantities involved are:

- Centrifugal Blower, Max 5 hp, 900 scfh
- Particulate Filter, 5 micron, 900 scfh
- Digester Gas Chiller
- Piping
- Concrete Slab, approx. 8' x 32'
